Item #25, Domestic Water Treatment and Filtering Equipment: A license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed and the installation complies with the applicable code. If the enforcing agency determines a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the responsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #25 and the appropriate water distribution pipe (system) size fee.

VIII. Instructions for Completing Application

Make checks payable to "City of St. Joseph"

General: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the City of St .Joseph Inspection Department. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Plumbing Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. The telephone number for the inspector will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR MECHANICAL PERMIT - Lines 2,3,4,5,11,12,19,29,32,46 of application AND PLUMBING PERMIT – Line 27 of application

Code Restrictions for Installation and Placement of Mechanical Equipment Based on Michigan Residential Code and the City of St. Joseph Zoning Ordinance. Contact Ken Jewell, Mechanical Inspector with questions at 269.287.0425.

- 1. Per MRC: Section 1804.2.6, #6, Power exhaust terminations shall be located not less than ten feet (10') from lot lines and adjacent buildings.
- 2. Per the City of St. Joseph Zoning Ordinance Section 3.9.3.c (residential, commercial, office and industrial properties) all heat pumps, air conditioners, emergency generators, and water pumps must comply with the following:
 - a. <u>May not be installed in the Front Yard</u> (area between the building and the <u>street</u>);
 - b. When located in the rear or to the side of the structure, <u>must be at least three</u> <u>feet (3') from the rear or side lot line</u>.
- 3. For all multi-family, commercial, or office properties (does not pertain to single family homes or two-unit residential structures), Section 19.5.2 of the Zoning Ordinance must also be met:

When located outside of a Building, support equipment including air conditioning and heating devices, water and gas meters, but not including plumbing or exhaust vents or chimneys, <u>are to be screened to the height of</u> <u>the particular piece of equipment</u> as follows:

- a. Roof-mounted or wall mounted equipment must be screened by architectural features from the view of pedestrians on abutting streets and parcels.
- b. Other <u>Exterior equipment is to be</u> <u>screened by landscaping, a solid wall</u> <u>or fencing from the view of</u> <u>pedestrians on abutting streets and</u> <u>parcels.</u>
