**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 17 "MOBILE HOMES, TRAILERS AND  
RECREATIONAL VEHICLES" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES  
OF THE CITY OF ST. JOSEPH, MICHIGAN**

**THE CITY OF ST. JOSEPH ORDAINS** that Chapter 17 of the Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

**MOBILE HOMES, TRAILERS AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES**

**Sec. 17-1. Definitions.**

The following words and phrases, when used in this chapter, shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them:

*Mobile home* shall mean "mobile home" as defined in the "mobile home commission act," (MCL 125.2301 et seq.).

*Recreational vehicles* shall mean a vehicle that has its own motive power or is mounted on or towed by a motor vehicle and is primarily designed and used as temporary living quarters for recreational, camping, travel, or seasonal use purposes as defined in section 49a of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.49a.

**Sec. 17-2. Public parking.**

Except as provided below, no person shall park or permit the parking of any mobile home or recreational vehicle upon any public highway, street, alley, park, or other public place within the city.

Emergency or temporary parking or stopping is permitted on any street, alley, or highway for not longer than one hour subject to any other and further prohibitions, regulations, or limitations imposed by the traffic and parking regulations for that street, alley, or highway, or for the time and location approved by the City Commission as part of a special event application.
